**Part III DETAILED ACTION**

1. Claims 1-63 are pending.

**Restriction/Election**

2. Restriction to one of the following inventions is required under 35 U.S.C. 121:

Group I. Claims 1-24, drawn to a method of detecting abnormal endometrial glandular development, classified in class 435, subclass 7.1.

Group II. Claims 25-36, drawn to a method of assessing the suitability of the endometrium for embryo implantation, classified in class 435, subclass 7.1.

Group III. Claims 37-60, drawn to a method of assessing the effects of hormone replacement therapy, classified in class 435, subclass 7.1.

Group IV. Claims 61-63, drawn to detecting cancer, classified in class 435 subclass 7.1.

The inventions are distinct, each from the other because of the following reasons:

3. Groups I-IV are unique methods. Each method requires the detection of unique physiological conditions from women at different stages of life and menstrual cycle, therefore each method is patentably distinct from the other.

4. Because a search of these four distinct inventions would not be co-extensive with a search of the others, an examination and search of two or more inventions in a single application would constitute a serious undue burden on the examiner.

5. Because these inventions are distinct for the reasons given above and have acquired a separate status in the art because of their recognized divergent subject matter, restriction for examination purposes as indicated is proper.

6. Applicant is reminded that upon the cancellation of claims to a non-elected invention, the inventorship must be amended in compliance with 37 CFR 1.48(b) if one or more of the currently named inventors is no longer an inventor or at least one claim remaining in the application. Any amendment of the inventorship must be accompanied by a diligently-filed petition under 37 CFR 1.48 (b) and by the fee required under 37 CFR 1.17 (h).


