Part III DETAILED ACTION

1. Claims 1-24, 37-53 and newly added claims 64-82 are pending.

Applicant's election with traverse of Group I, claims 1-24 in Paper No. 9 is acknowledged. The traversal is on the ground(s) that it would not be an undue burden to search claims 37-53 in addition to claims 1-24. This is not found persuasive because the difference between the two groups is group of patients being used, in the elected group patients who are potentially infertile are being tested while in Group III, the patients are undergoing hormone replacement therapy, one group would not be obvious over the other, as such they are patentably distinct.

The requirement is still deemed proper and is therefore made FINAL.

Accordingly, claims 37-53 are withdrawn from further consideration by the examiner, 37 CFR 1.142(b), as being drawn to non-elected inventions.

2. In a review of the file wrapper, it appears as if Applicant filed an IDS on 6-29-01. Applicant is requested to resubmit said IDS, as it can not be located.

The following is a quotation of the first paragraph of 35 U.S.C. 112:

The specification shall contain a written description of the invention, and of the manner and process of making and using it, in such full, clear, concise, and exact terms as to enable any person skilled in the art to which it pertains, or with which it is most nearly connected, to make and use the same and shall set forth the best mode contemplated by the inventor of carrying out his invention.

3. Claims 1-24 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 112, first paragraph, as containing subject matter which was not described in the specification in such a way as to reasonably convey to one skilled in the relevant art that the inventor(s), at the time the application was filed, had possession of the claimed invention.

Applicant has no support in the originally filed claims or specification for diagnosing <u>any</u> woman suspected of an abnormality in endometrial glandular development.

In applicant's amendment filed 8-7-02, it is stated no new matter is added by the amendment, however there is no specific guidance to where they have support for such a broadening of the claim, and after a review by the Examiner such support could not be located. 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4. Claims 64-82 are objected to as being dependent upon rejected claims.
