The following amendments and remarks are being submitted pursuant to the response to the Office Action of August 29, 2002. provisions of 37 CFR 1.111 in response to the Office Action of August 29, 2002.

IN THE CLAIMS:

Please amend claims 1, 5, 7 and 12 as follows:

1. (Amended) An antislip fabric capable of maintaining garments in place with respect to each other, the antislip fabric comprising two different warp threads interlaced with west threads in the form of leno weave to provide a roughened or irregular surface.

5. (Amended) The antislip fabric as set forth in claim 1 wherein said roughened or irregular surface has a plurality of spaced-apart nubs fomed on both sides of each gap between two adjacent weft threads.
