REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE

1. The following is an Examiner's Statement of Reasons for Allowance:

Claims 1-42 are allowable over the prior art of record.

The examiner has found that the prior art of record does not teach or suggest or render obvious a method, a computer program product, and a cache system for processing a user request for an electronic product. The major difference in the independent claims not found in the prior art of record that if the electronic product is successfully provided by the cache to the user, then the cache generating confirmation data that indicates that the electronic product was successfully provided from the cache to the user as set forth in the specification and recited in the independent claims 1, 16, and 31.


