REMARKS

In a telephone interview with Examiner Manoharan on October 8, 2003, the Examiner indicated that the Amendment After Final of July 31, 2003 would not be entered, but that independent claims 6 and 10 were considered allowable. The applicants are hereby cancelling all of the remaining claims, except dependent claims 7 and 9.


Because this amendment places the application in condition for allowance without requiring further search or consideration, it is submitted that the amendment should be entered.
