This paper and amendments are responsive to the Final Office Action mailed November 3, 2003, which sets a shortened statutory period for response of 3 months with a due date on or before February 3, 2004. This response is being filed within the period set for response. This application currently includes pending claims 1-19 and 21-36. Pending claims 1, 3-10, 21-23, 31, and 33, stand rejected under 35 U.S.C. §102(b) as anticipated by Perronin ('007). Claims 1, 3-12, 14, and 21-34 stand rejected under 35 U.S.C. §102(e) as anticipated by Bednarek ('878). Claims 2, 13, and 15-16 stand rejected under 35 U.S.C. §103(a) as unpatentable over Bednarek ('878). In addition, claims 17-19 and 35-36 stand rejected under 35 U.S.C. §103(a) as unpatentable over the combined teachings of Bednarek ('878) and Pagano et al. ('988). This response, additionally, includes amendments to the claims as follows:
