DETAILED ACTION

1. The present Office Action is responsive to Applicant's Amendment filed June 17, 2003. The Examiner acknowledges the amendments to Claims 5-8, 11 and 14, and the cancellation of Claims 1-4 and 13. Accordingly, Claims 5-12 and 14 remain pending in the instant amended Application.

Allowable Subject Matter

- 2. Claims 5-12 and 14 have been allowed.
- 3. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

As to Claims 5-10, patentability resides in **the combination of** setting the planar surface of the another electric element to be slightly smaller than a size of each of the rectangular areas which are obtained by sectioning the sheet surface by n x m (where n and m are integers larger than 2) and wherein the planar surface of the another electric element is accommodated within one of the rectangular areas, as viewed in a direction perpendicular to the sheet surface, in combination with the other limitations of base Claim 5.

As to Claims 11-12, patentability resides in the claimed dimensional and mechanical properties of the electronic circuit chip defined by $3PL^2 + 6WL + \sigma H^2 \le 0$, in combination with the other limitations of base Claim 11.

As to Claim 14, patentability resides in the limitation wherein the planar surface of the electronic circuit chip and the contour of the antenna are accommodated within

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the planar surface of the capacitor as viewed in a direction perpendicular to the sheet surface, in combination with the other limitations of the claim.

5. Claims 14, 11, 12, 5-7, 9, 10 and 8 of the instant allowed Application will be renumbered as Claims 1-9, respectively, for publication in the issued patent.
