DETAILED ACTION

REASONS FOR ALLOWANCE

1. After further search and thorough examination of the present application claims 155-189 are found to be in condition for allowance over the prior art of record.

The following is an Examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: the present invention relates to a driving method of a liquid crystal display device, which displays information by illuminating display elements, an image display device, and an illumination device.

The first cited reference, Chen (U.S. Pat. No. 5,592,193) discloses a backlighting arrangement for LCD display panel. The second cited reference, Morishita et al. (U.S. Pat. No. 6,504,587) discloses a LCD device in which the inner frame having sidewall.

However, none of the cited references either singular or in combination discloses a display device comprising an illuminating section for illuminating the display elements, wherein "the illuminating elements respectively illuminate the display elements in such a manner that each illuminating element group respectively illuminates a display element group in a second luminance in a period from time P to time (P + tb), and illuminates in a first luminance for once or more in a period from the time (P + tb) to time (P + tb)"

These limitations, in conjunction with all other limitations of the base claims were not shown by, would not have been obvious over, would have been fairly suggested by the prior art of record.
