

## **REMARKS**

This Amendment is submitted in reply to Fourth Office Action. Applicant respectfully requests reconsideration and further examination of the patent application under 37 C.F.R. § 1.111.

Claims 1, 3, 18, 21, 23, and 37 have been cancelled without prejudice, claims 2, 6, 7, 20, 24, 25, 48, and 49 have been amended as shown above, and claims 53-64 have been added. Upon entry of the foregoing Amendment claims 2, 6-18, 20, 24-35, 38-43, and 48-64 are pending in the application. The amendments are believed to introduce no new matter, and their entry is respectfully requested. Based on the above amendment and the following remarks, Applicant respectfully requests that the Examiner reconsider and withdraw all outstanding rejections.

### **Summary of Fourth Office Action**

Claims 1-3, 6-10, and 17 were rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over Wingard U.S. Patent 6,295,318.

Claims 18, 20-21, 23, 24-28, 35, 44, and 47-52 were rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over Lee U.S. Patent 5,479,397.

Claims 11-16, 29-34, and 38-43 have been objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but would be allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims.

### **Remarks regarding §103(a) rejections**

The applicant respectfully traverses all claim rejections. However, in order to expedite allowance of the application, all rejected base claims have been amended to include limitations deemed allowable by the Action. Other claims have been cancelled or left in their original or previously amended form as appropriate, and claims that include limitations deemed allowable by the Action have been added. The applicant specifically reserves the right to seek additional claims in a future filed continuation application.

## Conclusion


