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DETAILED ACTION

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 103

1. The following is a quotation of 35 U.S.C. 103(a) which forms the basis for all

obviousness rejections set forth in this Office action:

(a) A patent may not be obtained though the invention is not identically disclosed or described as set forth in section 102 of this title, if the differences between the subject matter sought to be patented and the prior art are such that the subject matter as a whole would have been obvious at the time the invention was made to a person having ordinary skill in the art to which said subject matter pertains. Patentability shall not be negatived by the manner in which the invention was made.

2. Claims 1-3 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over

Ishimatsu in view of Hoshino.

Ishimatsu discloses the use of a High Hat Stand comprising a rod which is

movable upward and downward by a foot pedal (12) so as to move a moveable cymbal

up and down relative to a stationary cymbal (7), the rod being comprised of an upper

rod (3) that are threadably connected in a disengageable fashion in a connecting

section (see figure 2). Ishimatsu does not disclose the use of an elastic section.

Hoshino discloses the use of an elastic section (40, 50) that is compressed upon

connection of the rod members undergoes elastic recovery upon separation of the rod

members is disposed in the connecting section.

Regarding claims 2 and 3, Hoshino discloses a device that allows the lower rod member and the upper rod member to undergo elastic recovery upon separation from upper rod.

3. Claims 4-9 are allowed.
