## DETAILED ACTION

### *Election/Restrictions*

1. Restriction to one of the following inventions is required under 35 U.S.C. 121:
  - I. Claims 1-9,17-19,21-27,37,39-45,65-67,70-74, and 115-117, drawn to content distribution system which fulfilling the client request and response through the use of electronic mail, classified in class 709, subclass 206.
  - II. Claims 10-11,20,28-29,35-36,46-48,50-61,75-76,94-102,104,106,108,110, and 112 drawn to a content distribution system which distribute content item request from the client device to the portable terminal based upon the data representing an environment of content execution, classified in class 709, subclass 231.
  - III. Claims 12-16,30-34,49,62-64,68-69,77-93,103,105,107,109,111,113,114, and 118 drawn to a database searching with a specify condition, and displaying result based upon the content-specifying data, classified in class 709, subclass 217.

2. The inventions are distinct, each from the other because of the following reasons:

3. Inventions of Group III is related as combination and subcombinations of Group I-II.

Inventions in this relationship are distinct if it can be shown that (1) the combination as claimed does not require the particulars of the subcombinations as claimed for patentability, and (2) that the subcombinations has utility by itself or in other combinations (MPEP 806.05c). In the instance case, the combination (Group III) as claimed does not require the particulars of the subcombinations (Group I-II) as claimed because to both subcombinations and combination are presented and assumed to be patentable, the omission of specific detail of the subcombinations as

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recited in claims 1-11,17-29,35-48,50-61,65-76,94-102,104,106,108,110,112, and 115-117, in the combination as recited in claims 12-16,30-34,49,62-64,68-69,77-

93,103,105,107,109,111,113,114, and 118 is evidence that the patentability of the combination does not rely on the details of the specific subcombinations. The subcombinations of Group I-II has separate utility such as content distribution system which fulfilling the client request and response through the use of electronic mail, and a content distribution system which distribute content item request from the client device to the portable terminal based upon the data representing an environment of content execution.

4. Inventions of the Group I-II are related as subcombinations disclosed as usable together in a single combination. The subcombinations are distinct from each other if they are shown to be separately usable. In the instant case, invention of Group I-II have separate utility such as content distribution system which fulfilling the client request and response through the use of electronic mail, and a content distribution system which distribute content item request from the client device to the portable terminal based upon the data representing an environment of content execution. See MPEP 806.05(d).

5. Because these inventions are distinct for the reasons given above and the search required a separate status in the art as shown by their different classification, the search required for one Group is not required for other Groups, restriction for examination purposes as indicated is proper.

6. Applicant is advised that the response to this requirement to be complete must include an election of the invention to be examined even though the requirement be traversed (37 CFR 1.143).

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
