SIGNAL

In a decision mailed 08 April 2002, this Office dismissed applicants' renewed submission under 37 CFR 1.42. Specifically, the renewed submission included a declaration which did not identify all the inventors and which could not be read in combination with the previously filed declaration.

On 31 May 2002, applicants filed the "Response To Communication" considered herein as a second renewed submission under 37 CFR 1.42.
