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ADVISORY ACTION

Continuation of Item No. 2. NOTE: The proposed amendments will not be entered because they raise new issues that would require further consideration and/or search, and they are not deemed to place the application in better form for appeal by materially reducing or simplifying the issues for appeal, specifically the new limitation of optical density. The Examiner also notes that although proposed amendments were made to correct most of the issues raised under 35 U.S.C. 112, the rejections of Claims 30 and 31 were not fully addressed, most importantly the particle size of 3-20 microns cited in Claim 31.

Continuation of Item No. 5. NOTE: The Applicant's remarks filed 2/24/04 have been considered but are not persuasive considering they are directed to the proposed amendments that have not been entered for the above recited reasons.
