



This is in response to the Notice of Abandonment for failure to respond the Office Action, which was mailed to Applicant's counsel on December 1, 2004, with respect to the above identified application.

Applicant respectfully petitions to withdraw the holding of abandonment pursuant to 37 CFR 1.181, based on the following evidence.
