This is in response to the petition under 37 CFR 1.181, filed October 22, 2003, for withdrawal of abandonment of the above identified application based on filing of a timely reply. The delay in acting on this petition is regretted, but may have been caused by an incorrect Serial Number.

A review of the file history shows that the examiner mailed a Final Office action to applicants on January 22, 2003, setting a three month shortened statutory period for reply. On July 21, 2003, applicants filed a set of RCE papers including an amendment to the claims and request and fee for a three month extension of time. On August 22, 2003, the examiner mailed a Notice of Abandonment to applicants based on a telephone interview summary (it is not clear that the examiner actually talked with applicants' attorney or merely left a message). However the RCE papers have now been correlated with the file and will be processed accordingly. In view of the evidence presented the Notice of Abandonment was mailed in error and is withdrawn and the application is restored to pending status with the mailing of this decision.

The petition is **GRANTED**.

The application has been returned to TC 1600 for processing of the RCE papers, the fees have been charged to Deposit Account No. 22-0365, as directed. The application will then be forwarded to the examiner for further.
