DETAILED ACTION

1. This Office Action is response to Applicants' RESPONSE filed on 01/16/2007.
2. Claims 1-13, 15, 18, 20-21 and 23-27 have been cancelled.
3. Claims 14, 16, 17, 19 and 22 are allowed.

Allowable Subject Matter

4. The present application has been thoroughly reviewed. Upon searching a variety of databases, the examiner respectfully submits that claims 14, 16, 17, 19 and 22 are allowed in light of the applicants' argument and in light of the prior arts of made record.
5. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

The claimed invention is directed to a method for sharing highlighted passages and notations in an electronic book. A user can highlight passages and/or notes, which are tagged and automatically sent to a designated set of recipients. The designated recipients can enter search criteria so that the highlighted passages and/or notes are displayed in their electronic book or at least remote electronic book based on the specified criteria.

The closest prior arts, Patent No.: US 6,363,352 B1 issued to Graham et al. (hereinafter Graham) teaches a method for highlighted or annotated text of stored electronic document or e-book, which contains plurality of pages including table of contents, receiving a user input via input device such as mouse or keyboard and highlighting the selected text after the e-book is displayed. Patent No.: US 6,697,999 B1 issued to Breuer et al. (hereinafter Breuer) teaches e-book such as PDAs over The

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Interne network transmitting the portion of the selected text from one PDA machine to a remote machine over Internet network and displaying the sorted text in an alphabetic order.

In combination, Graham and Breuer fail to teach "sorting the selected text from the at least one remote electronic book." (Remarks, page 5-6).


6. These distinct features, in conjunction with all other limitations of the dependents and independent claims render claims 14, 16, 17, 19 and 22 allowable.
