None of the prior art of record describe or suggest an isolated nucleic acid encoding a hek-L protein capable of binding hek, wherein said nucleic acid comprises a nucleotide sequence that is at least 90% identical to at least one sequence selected from nucleotides 83-796, nucleotides 83-745, nucleotides 140-796, and nucleotides 140-745 of SEQ ID NO: 1.

None of the prior art of record describe or suggest an isolated nucleic acid encoding a hek-L protein capable of binding hek, wherein said nucleic acid comprises a nucleotide sequence that is at least 90% identical to at least one sequence selected from nucleotides 28-630, nucleotides 28-573, nucleotides 94-630, and nucleotides 94-573 of SEQ ID NO: 3.
