DETAILED ACTION

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

The following is a quotation of the appropriate paragraphs of 35 U.S.C. 102 that form the basis for the rejections under this section made in this Office action:

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless –

(b) the invention was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale in this country, more than one year prior to the date of application for patent in the United States.

Claims 1, 18-22 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being anticipated by Edelman (US006064986A) as applied in the prior office action. See prior office action for specific citation and reasoning.

Response to Amendment

Applicant's amendment to the abstract has overcome the objection for the Specification.

Response to Arguments

Applicant's arguments see page 3 lines 12 through page 6, filed 7/24/2006, with respect to claims 1, 18-22 have been fully considered and are persuasive. The 35 USC 101 rejection of 4/24/2006 has been withdrawn.

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Applicant's arguments filed 7/24/2006 have been fully considered but they are not persuasive with respect to the 35 USC 102 rejection of claims 1 and 18-22.

Applicant's argues that nowhere does the Edelman reference teach the receiving steps of claim 1 of the instant application, especially the receiving of an electronic confirmation form the grantor over the computer network to establish the trust with the conveyed funds. Examiner disagrees. Edelman discloses receiving an electronic confirmation from the grantor over the network establishing a trust with the funds in cols 1, 5 and 8-14.
