Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 112

Claims 1,2,7,8,9,11,12,35,36 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 112, first paragraph, because the specification, while being enabling for financial securities, it does not reasonably provide enablement for nonfinancial properties, such as real property. The specification does not enable any person skilled in the art to which it pertains, or with which it is most nearly connected, to use the invention commensurate in scope with these claims.

The examiner includes defines financial security as a fungible, negotiable instrument representing financial value. Further, securities are broadly categorized into debt securities (such as banknotes, bonds and debentures); equity securities, e.g., common stocks; and derivative (finance) contracts, such as forwards, futures, options and swaps.

Claims 1,2,7,8,9,11,12,35,36 would be allowable if rewritten or amended to overcome the rejection(s) under 35 U.S.C. 112, 2nd paragraph, set forth in this Office action.
