## Reasons for Allowance

1. Claims 20, 22-29, 31, 41, 43-54, 56-58, and 74-79 are allowed.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

Independent claim 76 recites a linoleum sheet containing over the entire thickness thereof flakes comprising an organic polymeric material, wherein each of the flakes has a thickness in the range of 1.0 to 400 microns and wherein the linoleum sheet includes from about 1% to about 15% by weight of the flakes.

Independent claim 77 recites a linoleum sheet containing over the entire thickness thereof flakes comprising an organic polymeric material, the flakes having a thickness in the range of 1.0 to 100 microns, wherein the organic polymeric material comprises the reaction product of: a) a mixture of a partial ester of maleic acid anhydride and dipropylene glycol with citric acid; with b) at least one epoxidation product of a carboxylic acid ester or a mixture of the epoxidation products.

The closest prior art, Dobry and Harris, fail to disclose or render obvious a linoleum sheet containing over the entire thickness thereof flakes comprising an organic polymeric material wherein the linoleum sheet includes from about 1% to about 15% by weight of the flakes or wherein the organic polymeric material comprises the reaction product of: a) a mixture of a partial ester of maleic acid anhydride and dipropylene glycol with citric acid; with b) at least one epoxidation product of a carboxylic acid ester or a mixture of the epoxidation products.
