DETAILED ACTION

Examiner's Comments

1. This action is in response to applicant's request for continued examination received 2 March 2004. Applicant has amended claims 9, 16 and cancelled claims 10, 17. The pending claims are now 9, 11-12, and 16.

Reasons For Allowance

2. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The prior art of record fails to anticipate or obviate the claimed longitudinal folding device. Specifically, the amendments to the claims have added such structural limitations as the longitudinal folding hopper having a hopper insertion plate and hopper flank plates; a hopper guide device including an upper cover plate and left and right guide devices wherein the upper cover plate and left and right guide devices are spaced from and enclose the hopper insertion plate and hopper flank plates; a high voltage source having different polarities with the different polarities being connected to the longitudinal folding hopper and to the hopper guide device being matched to charges applied to adjacent webs of an electrically interlocked paper web train; and electrically insulating means supporting the hopper guide.

Any comments considered necessary by applicant must be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee and, to avoid processing delays, should preferably accompany the issue fee. Such submissions should be clearly labeled "Comments on Statement of Reasons for Allowance."
