

## **DETAILED ACTION**

### ***Response to Amendment***

This Office Action is responsive to Applicant's amendment and request for continued examination of Application 09/929,184 filed on November 25, 2009.

The amendment contains previously allowed claims: 1 and 3-19.

The amendment contains new claim: 30 (submitted as 20, changed to 30 per Examiner's Amendment as claim 20 was previously canceled).

A request for continued examination under 37 CFR 1.114, including the fee set forth in 37 CFR 1.17(e), was filed in this application after final rejection. Since this application is eligible for continued examination under 37 CFR 1.114, and the fee set forth in 37 CFR 1.17(e) has been timely paid, the finality of the previous Office action has been withdrawn pursuant to 37 CFR 1.114. Applicant's submission filed on November 25, 2009 has been entered.

### **EXAMINER'S AMENDMENT**

Claims 1 and 3-19 were previously allowed and remain allowable as they pertain to this RCE. Additionally, new claim 30 is allowable.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: new claim 30 contains the same allowable subject matter as independent claim 1 as previously allowed and is therefore also allowable.
