- (Currently amended) A method for treating a patient in order to induce an immune response to an antigen inducing immunity in a patient, comprising delivering a composition particle comprising a calcium phosphate nanoparticle having a pharmacologically-active agent the antigen at least partially coating the nanoparticle or impregnating the nanoparticle or both, wherein the particle has a diameter between about 300 nm and about 4000 nm and has a substantially spherical shape and a substantially smooth surface is delivered to a mucosal surface of the patient in need thereof, wherein the pharmacologically active agent is an antigen.
- 6. (Original) The method of claim 5, wherein the mucosal surface is selected from the group consisting of a nasal surface, upper airway, lower airway, pulmonary surface, oral surface, ocular surface, vaginal surface, and rectal surface.
- 7. (Original) The method of claim 5, wherein the particle is complexed with a pharmaceutically acceptable excipient and delivered as a spray, an aerosol, an ointment, an eye drop, a gel, a suspension, a capsule, a suppository, an impregnated tampon, or combinations thereof.
