DETAILED ACTION

Election/Restrictions

1. Claims 56-57 & 83-85 are withdrawn from further consideration pursuant to 37 CFR 1.142(b), as being drawn to a nonelected embodiment. Applicant timely traversed the restriction (election) requirement in the reply filed on 05-17-04.

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 112

- 2. The following is a quotation of the second paragraph of 35 U.S.C. 112: The specification shall conclude with one or more claims particularly pointing out and distinctly claiming the subject matter which the applicant regards as his invention.
- Claims 54-55 & 58-82 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 112, second 3. paragraph, as being indefinite for failing to particularly point out and distinctly claim the subject matter which applicant regards as the invention.

Re claim 54-55 & 74, the phrase "the bottom injector and the top injector layers forming a p-n junction" is unclear how to form the p-n junction between the bottom injector and top injector layers because the top injector is separated by an offset from the bottom injector.

Claims 58-73 & 75-82 are rejected because each includes the limitations of independent claim 54 & 74.

4. The lack of an art rejection with this office action is not an indication of allowable subject matter (i.e., even though the claims are rewritten or amended to overcome the rejection under U.S.C. 112 as discussed above). The

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disclosure/claimed language is such that it is impractical to conduct a reasonable search of the prior art by the Examiner.
