

Continuation of Substance of Interview including description of the general nature of what was discussed:
The examiner contacted Ms. Dvorson regarding allowable subject matter described in the specification at the top of page 30 and claimed separately in claims 3 and 16. The examiner suggested that incorporating the features of claims 3 and 16 in the spirit of the disclosure at the top of page 30, into each independent claim would make all claims allowable. Ms. Dvorson then faxed a copy of the discussed claim amendments to the examiner. The examiner agreed that the proposed amendments were sufficient to overcome the prior art. Ms. Dvorson consulted with the Applicants and agreed to the examiner's amendment by way of a voicemail on 2/16/07. Confirmation of the agreement was made in a telephone conversation on 2/20/07.
