


In response to the Notice of Allowance mailed March 15, 2006 in the above referenced application.

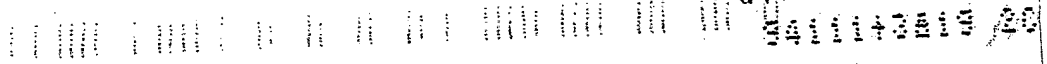
