

REMARKS

In response to the Office Action dated December 31, 2007, please enter the following remarks. The Examiner indicated that the application is in condition for allowance except for the listed formal matters. Applicant acknowledges that the Examiner indicated that the application is in condition for allowance, and further believes that the listed formal matters have been addressed.

The Examiner objected to the application under 37 CFR 1.172(a) as the assignee has not established its ownership interest in the patent for which reissue is being requested. An *Assent by Assignee for Filing of Reissue Application*, signed by Mariann McNally, was originally submitted with an Amendment filed on November 24, 2003. A copy of this Assent, indicating that the Assignee owns an undivided interest to the original patent, is attached. Further, a statement under 37 CFR 3.73(b) that was also previously filed on November 24, 2003 states that Kelsey-Hayes Company is the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in U.S. Patent No. 5,941,608 and details the chain of title for this patent. Therefore, the assignee has established its ownership interest in the patent. Thus, this matter should not prevent allowance of the application.

The Examiner stated that there is no indication of record that the party who signed the submission is an appropriate party to sign on behalf of the assignee. Applicant respectfully directs Examiner's attention to the August 4, 2005 Response to the Office Action dated February 4, 2005 in which this issue was addressed. The following text is copied from that response.

The Examiner has asserted that the person signing the submission establishing ownership interest, Mariann McNally, has failed to state his/her capacity to sign for the corporation or other business entity, and he/she has not been established as being authorized to act on behalf of the assignee.

Applicants respectfully disagree. Ms. McNally indicated her title to be "Assistant Secretary". She is a corporate officer of the Assignee corporation, with the apparent authority to sign, as denoted by her title. According to the MPEP § 324 (II) (A):

The submission may be signed by a person in the organization having apparent authority to sign on behalf of the organization. 37 CFR 3.73(b)(2)(ii). An officer (chief executive officer, president, vice-president, **secretary**, or treasurer) is presumed to have authority to sign on behalf of the organization. The signature of the chairman of the board of directors is acceptable, but not the signature of an individual director. **Modifications of these basic titles are acceptable, such as** vice-president for sales, executive vice-president, **assistant** treasurer, vice-chairman of the board of directors. (**emphasis added**)

Since the MPEP clearly indicates that the corporate title "Secretary" is presumed to have authority to sign on behalf of the organization, and that a modification of this basic title would be acceptable, and the MPEP even includes the modifier "assistant" among the modifiers specifically approved as acceptable, it is clear that, as Assistant Secretary, Ms. McNally has the apparent authority to sign on behalf of her organization, and she is not required to further establish her authority.

Nevertheless, Applicants have *previously supplied* a Statement Under 37 C.F.R. § 3.73(b), signed by Ms. McNally, which indicates (above her signature) that she is authorized to act on behalf of the assignee (see accompanying copy). Accordingly, the Examiner is requested to withdraw his requirement for another submission establishing ownership interest in the patent.

Therefore, the issue of whether the party who signed the submission is an appropriate party to sign on behalf of the assignee has been addressed. Thus, this matter should not prevent allowance of the application.

The Examiner further indicated that the application is defective because it fails to identify at least one error which is relied upon to support the reissue application. Applicant respectfully directs Examiner's attention to the November 24, 2003

Response to the Office Action dated May 23, 2003 in which this issue was addressed. The following text is copied from that Response.


The Examiner has noted that the reissue oath/declaration with this application is defective because it fails to identify at least one error which is relied upon to support the reissue application. The reissue application declaration submitted without signature upon filing of this reissue application, and subsequently submitted with signatures February 28, 2002, includes a statement of inoperativeness or invalidity of original patent, pursuant to 37 CFR § 1.175. This statement, on page 3 of the reissue declaration, asserts that "I believe the original patent to be partly inoperative or invalid by reason of (37 CFR § 1.175(a)(1)): the patentee claiming more or less than the patentee had a right to claim." However, a description of the error relied upon was not included. Therefore, a supplemental declaration including a description of the error relied upon is submitted herewith.

A copy of the supplemental declaration including a description of the error relied upon is included with this Response. The issue of the error which is relied upon to support the reissue application has been addressed. Thus, this matter should not prevent allowance of the application.

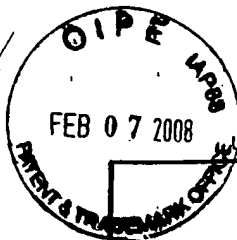
Per the requirement of 37 CFR 1.178, the original patent is enclosed with this response.





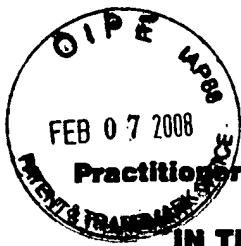
