REMARKS

Pursuant to the telephone conference on October 14, 2004 between the undersigned and Examiner Kubelik, applicants provide this Supplemental Amendment to present a new claim list identifying previously submitted but not entered claims 74-85 as "Not entered" in the listing of claims and to number the new claims presented herein as 86 and 87. This claim listing replaces the claim listing presented in the Amendment filed by Applicants on October 13, 2004, which inadvertently omitted identification of not entered claims 74-85 and inadvertently numbered the new claims presented therein as new claims 74 and 75. Applicants also provide language for new claim 86 herein as suggested by the Examiner to recite an isolated nucleic acid consisting of SEQ ID NO:1.
