DETAILED ACTION

Allowable Subject Matter

Claims 3-16 and 19-34 are allowed.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

In regards to independent claims 3, 19, 33, and 34, prior art does not teach assigning a suffix to the home of the object if the home of the object is not unique in the computing system environment, such that object identifiers for objects having a home that is not unique will be different from each other based on the suffix and if a home condition exists for one of the at least one representation of the object displayed on the graphical user interface, including the home and assigned suffix of the object in the representation of the one of the at least one representation of the object displayed on the graphical user interface, and if a home condition does not exist, omitting the home and suffix of the object from the representation of the one of the at least one representation of the object displayed on the graphical user interface in combination with all of the other claim limitations.

In regards to independent claims 9 and 25, prior art does not teach creating a transparent group object and further having its children identify its home (the transparent group's home) as their home and if a home condition exists for one of the at least one representation of the object displayed on the graphical user interface including the home of the object in the representation of the one of the at least one representation of the object displayed on the graphical user interface, and if a home condition does not exist, omitting the home of the object from the representation of the one of the at least

one representation of the object displayed on the graphical user interface in combination with all of the other claim limitations.
