<u>REQUEST TO RE-MAIL LAST OFFICE ACTION</u> <u>AND RE-SET RESPONSE PERIODS</u> <u>DUE TO PATENT OFFICE ERROR</u>

On the afternoon of June 4, 2007, the undersigned's firm received for the first time a USPS package from the USPTO with the Office Action dated 12/01/2006. The USPS postage stamp on the envelope was dated May 29, 2007 (copy attached).

According to our prior files, there was no outstanding Office Action. Based on the undersigned's investigation to date, it appears that the USPTO erroneously failed to associate this application with Customer Number 23117 - and therefore the Office Action of 12/01/2006 was improperly addressed and non-deliverable.

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
