DETAILED ACTION

1. Claims 1-23, 25-35, 37-60 and 62-69 are pending in the present application.

2. Claims 24, 36, 61 and 70 have been cancelled; and claims 16, 25, 31, 37, 53, 62 and 67 have been amended.

Allowable Subject Matter

- 3. Claim Claims 1-23, 25-35, 37-60 and 62-69 are allowed.
- 4. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

In the last correspondence claims 1-15, 26-30, 38-52 and 63-66 were allowed. Claims 19-25, 34-37, 56-62 and 69 were noted as allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims. Applicant's amendment overcomes the prior art rejection cited under 35 USC 103(a) citing Plantz et al. in view of Fogarasi et al.. Regarding independent claims 1, 26, and 38 the prior art of record fails to disclose storing generated attribute file in the subdirectory of the information class instance for which the attribute value is provided. Regarding independent claim 63 the prior art does not teach wherein the application program maintains multiple information class instances and wherein each instance includes at least one of the plurality of attribute values, one attribute file for each attribute value for each information class instance, wherein each attribute file provides one attribute value and is in the subdirectory of the information class instance as cited.

Regarding independent claims 16, 31, 53 and 67 the prior art of record fails to teach the limitation of a task subdirectory as claimed.
