IN THE CLAIMS:

Please amend the claims as follows:

- 1 3. (Amended) The carbonaceous refractory material in the first claim, where the X-
2 ray diffraction peak intensity ratio of the face (200) of the Ti_3O_5 to the face (111) of
3 titanium carbide is 1 % or less.

Please add the following newly-drafted Claim 6.

- 1 6. (New). The carbonaceous refractory material in the second claim, where the X-
2 ray diffraction peak intensity ratio of the face (200) of the Ti_3O_5 to the face (111) of
3 titanium carbide is 1 % or less.

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REMARKS


The amendments to the claims are to remove multiple dependencies.
