DETAILED ACTION

This Office action is in response to the amendment filed March 29, 2004 in which claims 9, 10, 24-25, 28-38, 40 and 47-49 were amended. The rejection of the claims under 35 U.S.C. 112, second paragraph, 35 U.S.C. 102(b) and 35 U.S.C. 103(c) are withdrawn in view of the amendment to the claims and Applicant's arguments.

1. This application is in condition for allowance except for the following formal matters: The disclosure is objected to because of the following informalities: Applicant has canceled claims 1-8. However, the specification refers to these claims and the limitations that were present in these claims. Since the pending claims will be renumbered upon allowance, it is suggested that all references to the claims be deleted from the specification.

Appropriate correction is required.

Prosecution on the merits is closed in accordance with the practice under Exparte Quayle, 1935 C.D. 11, 453 O.G. 213.

2. Claims 9-38 and 40-49 are allowed. The prior art fails to teach or suggest the aqueous lubricant as set forth in the claims. The novelty lies in the multi-ligand metal chelate.
