RESPONSE TO RESTRICTION REQUIREMENT

Sir:

Applicant herein responds to the restriction requirement dated October 16, 2002 (Paper No. 5).

Applicant elects with traverse the claims of Group II (claims 25-32 and 34-44). Applicant, of course, reserves the right to file one or more divisional applications covering the subject matter of the non-elected claims.

Applicant elects with traverse the remedial water species of alkaline ECA water, and for claims 38-39 elects as a contaminated species, heavy metal such as mercury. The use of alkaline ECA water is embraced by the scope of all claims. Treatment of mercury containing wastes is embraced by all claims.

The election of species is traversed because this requirement is inconsistent with reality of embodiments of the claimed invention. Applicant points out that waste materials are not homogenous and, in fact contain many substances such as lead, cadmium, mercury, PAH's and so on that are simultaneously treated by embodiments of the invention. Accordingly, all claims embrace both selected species.

Nevertheless, applicant notes that claim 34 lists four species and that among these four, carbonate free radical is selected, if an election of species is required for this claim. Mercury is selected for claims 38-39. Consideration and entry respectfully are requested.

A first office action on the merits is awaited.
