#### Information Disclosure Statement

## IN THE CLAIMS

a) In Claim 1 line 8, change "the polymer melt" to --a polymer melt--.

# Allowable Subject Matter

3. Claims 45-48,57-60, 68-70, 75-79, 94-96, 98,100-105, 114, 115 and 139-158 are allowed.

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The primary reasons for the indication of the allowability of claims 45-48,57-60, 68-70, 75-79, 94-96, 98,100-105, 114, 115 and 139-158 are:

Regarding claims 45-48, 68-70, 75-79, 94-96, 98, 100-105,114, 115 and 139-158, the prior art does not teach or fairly suggest in combination with the other claimed limitations a toneable conduit, wherein said wire is coated with a coating composition that prevents the wire from adhering to the polymer melt used to form the polymeric tube.

Regarding claims 57-60, the prior art does not teach or fairly suggest in combination with the other claimed limitations a method of coupling a first toneable conduit with a second tonebale conduit comprising the steps of providing a first toneable conduit having a continuous wire, wherein the wire is coated with a coating composition that prevents the wire from adhering to a polymer melt used to form the elongated polymeric tube; and a second toneable conduit having a continuous wire, wherein the wire is coated with a coating composition that prevents the wire from adhering to a polymer melt used to form the elongated polymeric tube.

These limitations are found in claims 45-48,57-60, 68-70, 75-79, 94-96, 98,100-105, 114, 115 and 139-158 are neither disclosed nor taught by the prior art of record, alone or in combination.
