

AMENDMENTS TO THE CLAIMS

1. (currently amended) A method to be performed in a computer, the method comprising:
 - installing a computer program in the computer, the computer program being partially disabled as installed;
 - ~~using the computer program to detect a need for the computer program in the computer;~~
 - ~~informing a user of usefulness of the computer program;~~
 - offering the computer program to the user after installation of the computer program in the computer; ~~and~~
 - providing the computer program to the user if after the user accepts the offer[[]];

and

informing the user of usefulness of the computer program when the user tries to uninstall the computer program after accepting the offer.
2. (canceled)
3. (previously presented) The method of claim 1 wherein the act of informing the user of usefulness of the computer program includes informing the user a number of a type of window detected by the computer program.
4. (original) The method of claim 1 wherein the act of providing the computer program to the user includes activating the computer program.
5. (original) The method of claim 1 wherein the act of providing the computer program to the user includes downloading components of the computer program from a remote computer.
6. (original) The method of claim 1 wherein the computer program includes a window-blocking computer program.
7. (currently amended) A method to be performed in a computer, the method comprising:
 - installing a computer program in the computer, the computer program being partially disabled as installed;
 - ~~using the computer program to detect a need for the computer program;~~
 - demonstrating the efficacy of the computer program to a user;
 - offering the computer program to the user after installation of the computer program in the computer; ~~and~~
 - fully activating the computer program if only after the user accepts the offer[[]];

and

informing the user of usefulness of the computer program when the user tries to uninstall the computer program after accepting the offer.

8. (original) The method of claim 7 wherein the computer program includes a computer program for blocking a certain type of window.
9. (previously presented) The method of claim 7 wherein the act of demonstrating the efficacy of the computer program to the user includes informing the user of the number of windows of a certain type detected by the computer program.
