

I CLAIM:

1. A mail program comprising:
a primary message having at least one primary recipient; and,
a secondary message having at least one secondary recipient, the secondary message associated with the primary message and processed simultaneously with the primary message.
2. The mail program of claim 1, wherein each of the at least one secondary recipient(s) are different than the at least one primary recipient(s).
3. The mail program of claim 1, wherein the at least one secondary recipient(s) are the same as the at least one primary recipient(s).
4. The mail program of claim 1, further comprising a plurality of primary recipients, wherein the at least one secondary recipient is one of the plurality of primary recipients.
5. The mail program of claim 1, wherein the primary message and secondary message are created by a sender and simultaneously transmitted by the mail program.
6. The mail program of claim 1, wherein the primary message and secondary message are simultaneously received by the mail program for one of the primary recipient and secondary recipient.

7. The mail program of claim 1, wherein the primary message and the secondary message are transmitted to each of the at least one primary recipient and the at least one secondary recipient as a single mail.

8. The mail program of claim 1, wherein at least one of the at least one secondary recipients receives the primary message and the secondary message.

9. The mail program of claim 1, wherein at least one of the at least one primary recipient receives the primary message, but not the secondary message.

10. The mail program of claim 1, wherein said mail program comprises a mail service.

11. The mail program of claim 1, wherein said mail program comprises a mail client.

12. An mail message comprising:
a primary message having at least one primary recipient; and,
a secondary message having at least one secondary recipient, the secondary message associated with the primary message and processed simultaneously with the primary message.

13. The email message of claim 12, wherein each of the at least one recipient(s) are different than the at least one primary recipient(s).

14. A software application having instructions that, when executed by a processor, cause the processor to execute the steps comprising the steps of:
processing a primary message having at least one primary recipient; and,
processing a secondary message having at least one secondary recipient, the secondary message associated with the primary message and processed simultaneously with the processing of the primary message.

15. The software application of claim 14, wherein each of the at least one secondary recipient(s) are different than the at least one primary recipient.

16. The software application of claim 14, wherein said processing the primary message comprises generating the primary message and said processing the secondary message comprises generating the secondary message.

17. The software application of claim 14, wherein said processing the primary message comprises receiving the primary message and said processing the secondary message comprises receiving the secondary message.
