As a below named inventor, I hereby declare that I reside at the address listed below, I am a citizen of the United States of America, and I believe I am an original, first and sols inventor of the subject matter described and claimed in U.S. Patent No. 6,202,870 (the "'870 Patent"), issued on March 20, 2001, for which a reissue patent is sought on the invention entitled VENTING CAP, the specification of which is attached hereto. The application for the '870 Patent was filed on March 29, 1999, as Application Serial No. 09/277,918 (the "918 Application").

I acknowledge the duty to disclose information known to me to be material to the patentability of this application in accordance with Title 37, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1.56.

I believe that the '870 Patent is partially inoperative because none of the claims in the '870 Patent are directed to an insert for use with a cap for capping a bottle where the insert has an annular section forming an opening and comprising a first surface opposite a second surface and a groove formed on the first surface, wherein when the cap is capping the bottle, a first portion of the groove extends beyond a first location external of the rim and a second portion of the groove extends beyond a second location external of the groove, wherein the first location is spaced spart from the second location. This aspect of my invention was described on column 4, lines 8-15 of the '870 patent,

where it is stated that "In a further embodiment, grooves 76 may be formed on the inner surface 78 of the cap top portion inner surface 46 (FIG. 6). These grooves should preferably span to the edge 80 of the inner surface, i.e., the location where the inner surface of the cap top portion intersects the annular wall 82 of the cap, or span to at least a location at/or beyond the outer edge of the bottle nack rim 42 when the cap is torqued onto the bottle nack" and on column 5, lines 8-11 of the '870 patent where it is stated that "Furthermore, the ridges or grooves may be formed, preferably by a molding or a machining process, on a disc 300 made from a hard or semi-hard material such as plastic (FIGS. 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14)." The novelty of this aspect of my invention was enroneously overlooked, as I did not appreciate the full scope of the invention being claimed at the time the '918 Application was filled and during its prosecution. My failure to recognize the full scope of the invention being claimed was inadvertent as is evidenced by the fact that although this novel feature was described in the specification of the '918 Application, it was not claimed. As a result of this failure, I claimed less than I had a right to claim in the '870 Patent. All errors being corrected in this reissue application up to the time of filing of this Declaration are without any deceptive intent on my part.

I hereby state that I have reviewed and understand the content of the above-identified application, including the original claims 1, 3-40 and any amendments made to such claims as well as added claims 41, 42 and 57 as currently pending.

I declare forther that all statements made herein of my own knowledge are true and that all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true; and further that these statements were made with the knowledge that willful false statements and the like so made are punishable by fine or imprisonment, both under Section 1001 of Title 18 of the United States Code and that such willful false statements may jeopardize the validity of the reissue application or any patent issuing thereon.
