Amendments to the Specification:

Please replace the paragraph starting on page 3, line 27 with the following amended paragraph:

In order to accomplish the desired selective removal of organic functional coatings, the source of the short wavelength UV 14 light must be capable of emitting a beam of light which is primarily comprised of a single, dominant wavelength. Examples of such light sources are lasers, and excimer lamps. Manufacturers of suitable excimer lamps are, for example, Ushio Inc. and Heraeus (↔) Noblelight Company.
