### **REMARKS**

This is responsive to the Board of Patent Appeals and Interferences Final Decision on Appeal No. 2009-003778 mailed February 26, 2010 and is filed in support of the concurrently-filed Request for Continued Examination. In their 26-February decision, the Board sustained the Examiner's rejection of claims 37 through 61. In response to this decision, the Applicants have canceled claims 37 through 61 and added new claims 62 through 70. The Applicants respectfully request the Examiner's entry and consideration of the newly added claims contained herein.

### Claims 62 through 66

New independent claim 62 and dependent claims 63 through 66 all recite various aspects of a method for transmitting graphical data. Support for this method can be found throughout the originally filed application, for example depicted in Figs. 7A and 7B and described in detail in the portion of the specification related thereto.

## Claims 67 through 70

New independent claim 67 and dependent claims 68 through 70 all recite various aspects of a system for transmitting graphical data. Support for this system can be found throughout the originally filed application, for example as depicted in Figs. 2A ad 2B and described in detail in the portion of the specification related thereto.
