Claim 1 (**canceled**): An extended text label for a tube container in combination, wherein a tube container includes a product dispensing end and a filling end opposite said product dispensing end, said filling end adapted to be sealed by a crimp method subsequent to filling said tube container with a selected product, wherein said label is capable of being securely joined to said filling end of said tube container by way of said crimp method.

Claim 2 (**canceled**): The combination of claim 1, further including a pliable attachment tongue extending outwardly from said label such that said tongue is capable of being securely joined to said filling end of said tube container by way of said crimp method.

Claim 3 (**canceled**): The combination of claim 1, further including a tear off portion for permanently removing said label from said tube container after said label has been securely joined to said filling end of said tube container by way of said crimp method.

Claim 4 (**canceled**): The combination of claim 2, further including a tear off portion for permanently removing said label from said tube container after said label has been securely joined to said filling end of said tube container by way of said crimp method.

Claim 5 (**withdrawn**): A method of manufacture of an extended text label for a tube container, comprising the steps of:

providing a first web material including a top ply having a front surface and a bottom surface;

providing a second web material including a base ply having a top surface;

selectively printing graphics on (i) said bottom surface of said top ply, and (ii) said top surface of said base ply;

selectively applying to said base ply (i) a release coating, and (ii) an adhesive coating;

selectively printing graphics on said front surface of said top ply; and

adhesively joining said first web and said second web.

Claim 6 (**withdrawn**): The method of claim 5, wherein said base ply is larger than side top ply, such that an attachment tongue may be provided by said base ply.

Claim 7 (new): An extended text label (for a multiple-use tube container) in combination, wherein a tube container includes a product dispensing end having a dispensing cap and a filling end opposite said product dispensing end, said filling end including a crimp closure portion that is ^{Prod. by} _{Process} crimped subsequent to filling said tube container with a selected product, wherein said label is securely joined to said filling end of said tube container by way of said crimp closure portion.

Claim 8 (new): The combination of claim 7, further including a pliable attachment tongue extending outwardly from said label such that said tongue is securely joined to said filling end of said tube container at said crimp closure portion.

Claim 9 (new): The combination of claim 7, further including a tear off portion for permanently removing said label from said tube container after said label has been securely joined to said filling end of said tube container at said crimp closure portion.

Claim 10 (new): The combination of claim 8, further including a tear off portion for permanently removing said label from said tube container after said label has been securely joined to said filling end of said tube container at said crimp closure portion.

Claim 11 (new): A method of providing an extended text label for a multiple-use tube container, comprising the steps of:

providing a multiple-use tube container having a product dispensing end with a dispensing cap, and a filling end opposite said product dispensing end;
filling said multiple-use tube container with a selected product at said filling end; and
securely joining an extended text label to said filling end of said tube container, by way of a crimp method of sealing said filling end.
