DETAILED ACTION

Papers Received

Receipt is acknowledged of the applicant's amendment, response, and request for continued examination, all received on 18 February 2005.

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 103

The text of those sections of Title 35, U.S. Code not included in this action can be found in a prior Office action.

The rejection of Claims 1-10, 12, and 13 under 35 U.S.C. 103(a) as being unpatentable over Gidlund is maintained.

Response to Arguments

The applicant's arguments, received on 18 February 2005, have been considered, but are not found to be persuasive.

The Gidlund reference clearly states that the term "extract" as used therein encompasses the juice of *Morinda citrifolia* as pressed from the fruit of that plant, which may be further processed as known in the art (See Column 4, Lines 26-30).

The examiner considers the property of selective cyclooxygenase-2 inhibition to be implicit and inherent to the disclosure of the prior art. As the art has already shown guidance that the invention of the Gidlund reference is useful for treating various conditions of pain, such as menstrual cramps, arthritis, sprains, and injuries, the examiner considers such a disclosure to

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be further guidance and evidence towards that rationale. The applicant is reminded that a composition known in the prior art does not become patentable upon the discovery of a new property. See MPEP § 2112. The burden therefore shifts onto the applicant to show the unobvious difference between the instantly claimed invention and the prior art that would render patentability unto the instantly claimed invention. All claims remain rejected.
