Remarks


Applicant thanks the Examiner for taking the time to discuss the instant application during a teleconference conducted on March 16, 2005. During the teleconference, Applicant explained the concepts of caching agent, snooping, and snoop filters in regard to independent claims 1, 7, 13, 17, 22. Applicant further explained how such concepts as incorporated into the claims of the present application were missing from the Bealkowski reference (US Patent 6,330,656) used to reject claims 1-27 under 35 USC 102(e). While Applicant believes progress was made in regard to each party understanding the other party's position, no agreement was reached as a result of the teleconference.

The foregoing is submitted as a full and complete summary of the teleconference conducted March 16, 2004.
