EXAMINER'S AMENDMENT

An examiner's amendment to the record appears below. Should the changes and/or additions be unacceptable to applicant, an amendment may be filed as provided by 37 CFR 1.312. To ensure consideration of such an amendment, it MUST be submitted no later than the payment of the issue fee.

Authorization for this examiner's amendment was given in a telephone interview with Howard Sobelman on October 27th, 2005.

The application has been amended as follows:

Claim 1, line 11, after "...treasure, scissors, writing instrument, clothes, puzzle," insert - - toy - -.

Claims 16 and 23 have been canceled.

Reasons for Allowance

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The specific limitations of "...analyzing a plurality of activity items...said plurality of activity items includes a hand game, book, activity mat, musical toy, song, nursery rhyme, rattle, ball, blocks, scoop, water, beads, puzzles, treasure, scissors, writing instrument, clothes, puzzle, animal, numbers, alphabet letters, and puppet...determining how said predetermined stage of brain development promotes early development of future school skills...creating an activity card related to said subset of plurality of activity items...including said subset of said plurality of activity items in a housing...providing at least one of an alternative activity item and a list of activity variations...providing said

plurality of activity items to said caregiver..." are not anticipated or made obvious over the prior art of record in the examiners opinion. For example, "Brilliant Beginnings" discloses a housing with instructions and activity cards for caregivers which suggest various activities for a child at a variety of brain development stages. However, "Brilliant Beginnings" fails to provide the various activity items with their system as well as lack the motivation for providing some items (for example, water, beads scoop, etc), thus there would have been no motivation to include such items with the system of "Brilliant Beginnings". Furthermore, "Brilliant Beginnings" fails to correlate their activities to specific school skills as claimed. Additionally, applicants affidavit attesting to a level of commercial success (made of record February 10, 2005) appears to achieve the requirements for demonstrating commercial success in the marketplace.
