## REMARKS

In response to a restriction requirement set forth in the Office Action mailed September 3, 2004, Applicants hereby elect Group I for examination, with traverse. Applicants elect with traverse because there is no undue burden to search all of the claims.

Applicants contend that the declaration is not defective under Rule 1.52(c) which states:

Any interlineation, erasure, cancellation or other alteration of the application papers filed must be made before the signing of any accompanying oath or declaration pursuant to § 1.63 referring to those application papers and should be <u>dated</u> and initialed <u>or signed</u> by the applicant <u>on the same sheet of paper</u>. (Emphasis added.)

The inventor Moosa Mohammadi has signed and dated right below the crossed out text, on the same page. Therefore, a replacement declaration is not required.
