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#### **DETAILED ACTION**

## Continued Examination Under 37 CFR 1.114

1. A request for continued examination under 37 CFR 1.114, including the fee set forth in 37 CFR 1.17(e), was filed in this application after allowance or after an Office action under *Ex Parte Quayle*, 25 USPQ 74, 453 O.G. 213 (Comm'r Pat. 1935). Since this application is eligible for continued examination under 37 CFR 1.114, and the fee set forth in 37 CFR 1.17(e) has been timely paid, prosecution in this application has been reopened pursuant to 37 CFR 1.114. Applicant's submission filed on May 10, 2004 has been entered.

# Information Disclosure Statement

2. The information disclosure statements (IDS) submitted on June 27, 2005 and September 12, 2005 were filed after the mailing date of the application on January 16, 2002. The submission is in compliance with the provisions of 37 CFR 1.97.

Accordingly, the information disclosure statements are being considered by the examiner.

## Allowable Subject Matter

The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

3. The prior art taken singly or in combination do not to teach or suggest a first address multiplexor connected to the first memory; a second address multiplexor connected to the second memory; a third address multiplexor connected to the third memory; a fourth address multiplexor connected to the fourth memory; a four-by-four

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switch connected to the first memory, the second memory, the third memory, and the fourth memory, having a first data input, a second data input, a first data output and a second data output, where the four-by-four switch switches with each frame between providing pixel data to the first memory and the second memory while receiving pixel data from the third memory and the fourth memory, and receiving pixel data from the first memory and the second memory while providing pixel data to the third memory and the fourth memory, as recited in Claim 1.

- 4. The closest prior art (Champion US006765579B2) teaches an address multiplexor (445) connected to the first memory (410) and the second memory (415, Figure 4; Col. 4, lines 32-34). However, Champion does not teach four memories each connected to a different multiplexor.
- 5. Another prior art (Chudnovsky US006519673B1) teaches a memory addressing system and method that provides high-performance access to a multi-bank memory having an arbitrary number of banks (Col. 1, lines 16-20), and has an address multiplexer (104, Figure 12A); Col. 13, lines 62-64). However, Chudnovsky does not teach four memories each connected to a different multiplexor.

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## Prior Art of Record

The prior art made of record and not relied upon is considered pertinent to applicant's disclosure.

- 1. Champion (US006765579B2) teaches methods and apparatus for implementing a pixel page system providing pixel pages using combined addressing (Col. 6, lines 43-45).
- 2. Chudnovsky (US006519673B1) teaches a memory addressing system and method that provides high-performance access to a multi-bank memory having an arbitrary number of banks (Col. 1, lines 16-20).
