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DETAILED ACTION

Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 112

- 1. The following is a quotation of the second paragraph of 35 U.S.C. 112:
 - The specification shall conclude with one or more claims particularly pointing out and distinctly claiming the subject matter which the applicant regards as his invention.
- 2. Claims 2 and 3 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 112, second paragraph, as being indefinite for failing to particularly point out and distinctly claim the subject matter which applicant regards as the invention. The recitation that the membrane is a semi-spherical membrane extended upwards is a repetition of language already found in claim 1.

Allowable Subject Matter

- 3. Claim 1 is allowed.
- 4. Claims 2 and 3 are objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but would be allowable if rewritten in independent form including all of the limitations of the base claim and any intervening claims.

Conclusion

5. The prior art made of record and not relied upon is considered pertinent to applicant's disclosure. The patent to Liang (6,622,407) discloses a water plug for an ornamental water ball, and the plug includes a round cylinder extended down from a flat plate (see Fig. 8). A semi-spherical membrane extends upward from the base of the cylinder. Further, a salient surface is located slightly higher than the flat plate, and it includes grooves. However, this reference cannot be used because its filing date is the same as that of the instant application.
