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#### **DETAILED ACTION**

### Response to Amendment

The Amendment, filed on 10/31/2006, has been entered and acknowledged by the Examiner.

Cancellation of claims 7, 8, 10, 20-22, 26-28, 36-39, 41, 42, 44-50, 52, 55, 57, 59-61, 63, and 65 has been entered.

### Claim Rejections - 35 USC § 102

The following is a quotation of the appropriate paragraphs of 35 U.S.C. 102 that form the basis for the rejections under this section made in this Office action:

A person shall be entitled to a patent unless -

(b) the invention was patented or described in a printed publication in this or a foreign country or in public use or on sale in this country, more than one year prior to the date of application for patent in the United States.

Claims 9, 11-17, 19, 24, 25, 29-31, 33, 34, 53, and 54 are rejected under 35 U.S.C. 102(b) as being anticipated by De Backer et al. (US 5,471,113).

Regarding claims 9, 11, 14-17, 19, 24, 25, 29-31, 33, 34, 53, and 54, De Backer discloses a gas discharge lamp including a tube filled with mercury vapor. The tube is coated with a phosphor blend including the following phosphors GdMgB<sub>5</sub>O<sub>10</sub>:Tb,

(Ba,Sr,Ca)<sub>5</sub>(PO<sub>4</sub>)<sub>3</sub>(Cl,F,OH):(Eu,Mn,Sb), and Lu<sub>3</sub>Al<sub>5</sub>O<sub>12</sub>:Ce. (Column 4 lines 10-20, Column 3 lines 60-65, and Column 4 lines 45-55) (Also see reference US 4,038,204 incorporated by reference for details of M<sub>5</sub>(PO<sub>4</sub>)<sub>3</sub>X). It is noted that the mercury discharge tube of this type emits UV radiation primarily at around 254nm and 405nm. The phosphor blend is likewise sensitive to this wavelength. The tube further emits a white light. (Column 1 lines 30-31).

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Regarding claims 12 and 13, De Backer does not explicitly state the color coordinates of the white light however color coordinates of a phosphor blend are an inherent property of the blend itself. In this case the color coordinates are substantially close to the reference color of a black body locus. (Column 1 lines 30-50)
