The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance: The prior art neither teaches nor fairly suggests the instant complexing of glycyrrhizin with famotidine (such that the composition is substantially free of uncomplexed famotidine), leading to increased solubility of famotidine. The closest prior art is the Zyck, et. al. (U.S. Patent No. 6,541,048) reference, which teaches use of glycyrrhizin in combination with famotidine (see col. 7, line 52). The reference does not teach complexing of glycyrrhizin with famotidine such that the composition is substantially free of uncomplexed famotidine; nor does it teach increased solubility of famotidine as a result of complexing with glycyrrhizin.
