2. The application has been amended as follows:

In the Claims

At claim 1, line 7, after "devices", please insert the following:

--, wherein the masking material comprises a plurality of discrete structures occupying less than the entire portion of the scribe line area adjacent the plurality of devices--.

Claims 8 and 9 have been canceled.

At **claim 10**, line 7, after "plurality of" please <u>delete</u> --devices-- and insert the following: --integrated circuits, wherein the scribe line area has a width dimension adjacent the

plurality of integrated circuits and the masking material comprises a plurality of discrete structures occupying less than the entire width dimension of the scribe line area--.

Claims 16 and 17 have been canceled.

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3. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for allowance:

Claims 1-3, 5-7, 10, 11 and 13-15 are allowed primarily because the references of record, singly or in combination, cannot anticipate or render obvious the following limitations (in combination as recited in claims 1 and 10): a masking material comprising a plurality of discrete structures overlying and occupying less than the entire portion of the scribe line area, wherein the masking material/discrete structures have a thickness that is equal to an defined by the step height of the devices/integrated circuits.
